Finished quilt measures: 54" $\times 72^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

six 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 4-1/4" squares
five 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 4" squares for the HSTs
eight $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
fourteen $2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 2 " $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
forty-eight $2 " \times 5$ " rectangles
From each of Fabrics B-M, cut:
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 4" squares for the HSTs
Trim the remainder of the strip to 3-1/2" wide, then subcut:
four 3-1/2" squares
one 3-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 3-1/4" squares. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of these squares.
Trim the remainder of the strip to TWO 1-1/4" wide strips, then subcut:
four $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips
four $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ strips
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 4" Fabric A square with a 4" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight A/B HSTs.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make eight HSTs from each of Fabrics C-M, pairing each one with Fabric A.


Assemble the Block Corner Units
Step 3: Gather:
one 3 - $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square one 4-1/4" Fabric A square
one $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip
one $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " Fabric B strip
one 2 " $\times 4-1 / 4$ " Fabric A strip
one 2 " $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip

Step 4: Place the $3-1 / 4$ " B square RST in one corner of the $4-1 / 4$ " Fabric A square, with the marked line oriented as shown here. Sew on the marked line. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press.


Step 5: With the completed Step 4 unit oriented as shown, sew the $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ B strip to the bottom edge of the unit. Press. Sew the $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ B strip to the right edge. Press. Sew the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " A strip to the right edge. Press. Sew the 2 " $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A strip to the bottom edge.
 Press.

The completed Block Corner Unit should measure 6-1/2" square. Repeat to make four Fabric B Block Corner Units.


Step 6: Repeat Steps 3-5 to make four Block Corner Units from each of Fabrics C-M.

Assemble the Blocks

## Step 7: Gather:

one Block Corner Unit from each of Fabrics B, C, H and I two HSTs from each of Fabrics B, C, H and I
one 3-1/2" square from eachof Fabrics B, C, H and I four $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the HSTs and Fabric A rectangles together, as shown, to make four 6-1/2" square units. Press.


Step 9: Sew the four 3-1/2" Fabric B, C, H and I squares together to form a four-patch, using the fabric placement shown in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 10: Sew the sections together in three rows of three. Press the unit seams toward the completed Step 8 units.

Step 11: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The completed Block should measure 18-1/2" square. Make four BCHI Blocks.
Step 12: Repeat Steps 7-11 to make:

four EDJK Blocks

four FGLM Blocks

## Assemble the Quilt



Step 13: Arrange the blocks into four rows of three blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 14: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 15: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
