## Difficulty Rating: Beginner

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From the Roll Up, cut:

one hundred fifty-six $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, from a mixture of prints

## From Fabric A, cut:

nine 6-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
seventy-eight $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles three 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
seven 1-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/2" $\times 70-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders
two 1-1/2" $\times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom inner borders
From Fabric B , cut:
seven $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" $\times 72-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
two 4-1/2" $\times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom outer borders
From the Binding, cut:
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Assemble the Blocks

## Step 1: Gather:

one 4-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle
two assorted print rectangles from the Roll Up
Sew together, as shown, sewing the Roll Up strips to the top edge of the Fabric A Rectangle. Press the seams away from Fabric A. The resulting Block should measure 6-1/2" x 8-1/2". Repeat to make forty Blocks like this.

## Step 2: Gather:

one 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangle two assorted print rectangles from the Roll Up

Sew together, as shown, sewing the Roll Up strips to opposite edges of the Fabric A Rectangle. Press the seams toward Fabric A. The resulting Block should measure
 $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make thirty-two Blocks like this.

Step 3: Gather:
one 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangle two assorted print rectangles from the Roll Up

Sew together, as shown, sewing the Roll Up strips to the top edge of the Fabric A Rectangle. Press the seams toward Fabric A. The resulting Block should measure 6-1/2" square. Repeat to make three Blocks like this.

Step 4: Gather:
one $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle one assorted print rectangle from the Roll Up

Sew together, as shown, sewing the Roll Up strip to the top edge of the Fabric $\square$ A Rectangle. Press the seams away from Fabric A. The resulting Block should measure $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat to make six Blocks like this.

## Assemble the Quilt

Step 5: Arrange the blocks into nine rows of nine blocks. Note the block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram and note that the bottom row is comprised of the Step 3 and Step 4 Blocks.

Step 6: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.


Make eight like this


Make one like this

Step 7: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.


Step 8: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
